

Health Services Research Academy Health Equity Scholarship for Trainees

Overview

The objective of the **Health Equity Scholarship for Trainees** is to *value* and *increase the quality* and *quantity* of health services research led by members of racial and ethnic groups that have historically been underrepresented in research.

Benefits

The scholarship recipient will receive free Tier 3 access to the HSR-Academy which includes:

- Access to 20 on-line, on-demand learning modules on fundamental principles of health services research
- Assignment of at least two nationally-recognized mentors: one clinical, one analytical
- Virtual meetings with their mentorship team every two weeks to complete a research project in less than 12 months
- Full statistical support as well as access to national databases for health services research

Application Eligibility

Eligibility requirements:

- Be a graduate-level (PhD, MD) student, postdoctoral researcher, or early career researcher who is no more than seven years outside of having earned your graduate degree
- Identify as American Indian/Alaskan Native, African American/Black, Asian American, Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander, and Hispanic/Latino (Applications from minority-serving institutions such as Tribal Colleges and Universities, Non-tribal American Indian/Alaskan Native-Serving Institutions, Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Hispanic-Serving Institutions, and Asian American and Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions with programs related to public health and health policy are strongly encouraged.)

Application

Application for the 2024 Health Equity Scholarship for Trainees is due October 1, 2023.

Applications must be sent to <u>research@childrenshospitals.org</u> and include the following:

- CV and Letter of Intent
- 1-2 paragraphs describing topics of research interest
- One recommendation letter from someone with whom the applicant has engaged in research

Selection Criteria

The selection committee will be looking for the following **proficiencies in the applicants**:

- Research interest (interesting research topic, potential impact of research)
- **CV and Letter of Intent** (applicant conveys dedication towards health services, demonstrates leadership, engagement in health services peer-review publications/presentations)
- **Recommendation Letter** (support from home institution/organization or other research-related references)
